

DRESS CODE POLICY

Shirts

- Solid Colored Polo shirts - solid colored polo shirts with a classic polo collar may be worn in **Navy Blue, Classic Red, Gold-Yellow, Light Blue, or White**. Polos may not have logos, patterns, or stripes. (Acceptable polo colors at Children's Place include: Nautico/Tidal, Classic Red/Ruby, Yellow Pencil, Brook/Daybreak, and White. Acceptable polo colors at French Toast include: Navy, Red, Gold, Blue, and White.) Both cotton and athletic/performance polos are acceptable.
- "Heads up for future planning: 26-27 is the last school year red will be part of the polo rotation. Students may continue to wear red this year, but please do not purchase red polos for 27-28 or beyond — red will no longer be an approved color starting in August 2027.
- MLS Spirit wear - all MLS shirts distributed by MLS are acceptable to wear unless ripped, torn, or stained.
- A solid white or navy tee shirt can be worn *under a polo*.
- Girls may wear solid white button down blouses under jumpers
- **Polos must be worn on chapel days.**

Pants

- All pants, shorts, skorts, and skirts must be **Black, Navy, or Khaki** and may not have a logo. (Children's Place colors include: Black, New Navy/Tidal, Flax/Bisquit, and Sandwash/Sandy. French Toast colors include: Black, Navy, and Khaki.)
- Girls **MUST** wear bike shorts or leggings under skirts, polo dresses, and jumpers. Leggings may be black or navy. Bike shorts and leggings are not permitted without a skirt, dress, or jumper.
- Appropriate styles can be found at French Toast and Children's Place. At Children's Place, accepted items will include the word "Uniform" in the product description.
- **No jeans, sweatpants, or jogger pants.**
- Pants may not be ripped or have frayed edges.

Polo Dresses and Jumpers

- Girls may wear Polo Dresses (with the polo collar) and Jumpers in navy and khaki.
- All polo dresses and jumpers must be worn with bike shorts or leggings (see above).
- Sleeveless jumpers must be worn with a white button-down collared shirt, or an approved school polo.

Shoes and Socks

- Students may wear **tennis shoes only**. Shoes must be appropriately sized to protect feet during outdoor play. Students may not wear boots, crocs, flip flops, etc.
- Solid colored socks may be white, black, or gray. Logos may not be visible on sock when wearing shoes.
- Socks must be worn with shoes to help prevent odor.

Winter Wear

- All sweatshirts and jackets worn **inside the classroom must be MLS Spirit wear OR solid Navy**.
- Coats and jackets worn outside may be any color or style.

Additional Notes

- Clothing is to be neat, clean, and the required size, fit, and length. Any tattoos must be covered.
- Jewelry may be worn in good taste. Dangling earrings are not permitted for safety reasons. Stud earrings are permitted for female students only.
- Student appearance, including hairstyles, should reflect respect for oneself, others, and the learning community. Hair must be clean and well-groomed. Unnatural hair colors (e.g., blue, green, pink) and severely shaved patterns or spiked/mohawk styles are not permitted. Administration will consider hairstyles connected to a student's cultural, ethnic, or religious background on a case-by-case basis."
